### **Architectural Historian**

The AH is responsible for gathering the information through historical research, field survey, and analysis needed to complete these and other types of projects and works with other members of the HPT to produce concise and technically accurate products that inform the decisions of clients and review agencies about the treatment of historic properties.

Qualified candidates have a graduate degree in architectural history, history, public history, or historic preservation and the following:

- at least 3 years' experience in conducting historic architectural property identification surveys and project effects assessments in compliance with Section 106 of the NHPA and state historic preservation laws
- outstanding historical research, synthesis, and technical writing skills
- strong knowledge of American historic architectural styles and property types and American history
- digital photography skills
- ability to lead projects and supervise staff and contribute effectively as a team member
